8. Treasurer’s Remarks – Betty McCamis for Karen Ross

Betty presented the financial information to Sept. 30, 2023.

Our local offering is only 53.3% of the budgeted amount and we have a deficit of \$17,565 to the end of September. Although our cash flow is OK at present because of savings, the growing deficit is concerning and we hope that local offerings will increase.

Betty presented a Charitable Tax Credits chart below.

CHARITABLE TAX CREDITS

Charitable Donations	Reduction in Taxes	Percent of Donations	Net Amount
\$500.00	\$190.80	38.2%	\$309.20
\$1000.00	\$422.80	42.2%	\$577.20
\$5000.00	\$2278.80	45.5%	\$2721.20

(Based on 2022 tax rates for the province of Manitoba)

This chart shows how much your income tax is reduced due to the charitable tax credit. For example, if you donate \$5,000, you receive a \$2,278.80 reduction in taxes so your net amount paid is only \$2,721.20. This is applicable to everyone who pays income tax and is not dependent on their income. Please keep this in mind when you are considering your charitable donations.

Discussion:

- suggestion that members review their offering through PAR (Pre-Authorized Remittance). PAR is the most efficient means of monthly offering. It provides the treasurer with a list of offering to Local and Missions. Offering by transfer to PCF through Access or by e-transfer is possible but it is much more difficult to track and would greatly increase the already demanding job of the treasurer. Please contact Karen Ross to set up or change your monthly offering through PAR.

- Explanation of Insurance and Property Taxes expense account: this title dates back to when we had land across from the mall. We now have insurance on our possessions and also directors and officers insurance to protect people on committees should someone decide to sue PCF. In future, Property Tax should be removed from the title of this category.

9. New Business

Discussion on disbursement of our things still at Gilbert School

- We are beginning to bring some of our things to the Lutheran Church and are not receiving the pressure of a deadline from FWG school
- Armchairs will come to Lutheran Church; other chairs will remain at FWG school
- Barb Lambert has removed most of our items from the Community Kitchen which will come to the church
- Will get a group of people to look at backdrop and other banners and make a decision
- Can keep the small side lectern; if the congregation is in agreement, Rob Smith could approach Sandy Saulteaux Centre to see if they can use the pulpit
- Suggestion to donate the choir skirting to Windsor Park United Church who have changed their setup and do not have draping for in front of the choir members
- Several hundred candles we can't use: can Sandy Saulteaux or Marcus Remple's church use them? Barrett at Fort Whyte Alive would be happy to have some to make fire starters
- Music needs to be sorted through by musicians. A lot of electronics will go to e-waste
- Toys in good condition can be donated to daycare or disposed of if they are outdated, etc.
- Large cabinet for the old organ – need to take it away or tell the school it's not needed
- We still have a balance of \$1300 for use of the Community Kitchen. This can be used for Dinner & Conversation sessions
- Dishes – does the Lutheran Church want us to bring them?
